INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

1. INFORMATION ON SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATIONS

The subject of the contract:

We are looking to contract a qualified company/individual for providing professional IT services to develop three prototype ideas into real products. The prototype ideas aim to contribute towards addressing reconciliation and conflict transformation issues as well as forms of working on peacebuilding topics in the youth context.

The prototypes have been developed by IT and Youth Workers during the Hackathon activity which has been organized this October in Peja. The solutions are digital web application platforms that aim to improve the gaps in existing features and online tools.

Therefore, LENS is looking to hire an experienced service provider to:

1. Provide professional IT services for developing prototype ideas into real products/services

Deadline for submission of the applicants:

The deadline for submission of applicants is before **NOVEMBER 18th 2022**. Any tender received after this deadline will be automatically rejected.

Address and meanings for submission of the applicants:

The applicants will submit their application using the:

- Best value for money, weighting 80% technical quality, 20% price.

The quality of each technical offer will be evaluated following the award criteria and the weighting detailed in the evaluation grid in Part of this tender dossier document. No other award criteria will be used. The award criteria will be examined following the requirements indicated in the Terms of Reference.

Experience:

General professional experience:

- Relevant working experience in the field of IT and web application development.
- Track record of previous IT web application projects during the last 3 years.

Specific professional experience:

- Preferably at least 3 years of experience in fields of Computer Sciences, IT, and relevant to this assignment. While Master Degree Academic level will be an advantage (where a university degree has been awarded on completion of a study in a university) in Computer Sciences, or IT;
- Rich experience with practical teaching skills;
- Excellent interpersonal, communication, and motivation skills, including experience in the facilitation of activities.
- Fluency in the English language, both spoken and written, and Computer literacy.

Methodology

• The methodology to be used for the services, details for each stage, together with a **preliminary working plan**.

Expected results

- Three prototype ideas have been developed into real products/services and are approved by the contracting partner.
- Facilitation of meetings with the team members who are part of the prototype ideas program;
- Final report for conducting and finalizing all tasks of the services that fall under this call.
- Warranty of the IT solutions, at least two years.



Duration/Timeframe

The intended start date is **November-December**. It is expected two months to complete all tasks.

Delays in meeting requirements and/or lack of quality of services will be considered as a reason for interruption. All products will be considered completed at the time when the Customer declares satisfaction with the results.

Location/Logistics and administration

It is expected that mainly the activities will be organized online since our partner organizations are located in different Western Balkan Countries.
